Competent person scheme: replacement windows and doors





As an installer of replacement doors and windows, for every installation you undertake, you must notify Local Authority Building Control (LABC) that the work complies with the relevant parts of the Building Regulations (parts A to P). However, this can be both costly and time consuming.
